No. 12020/284/25-5Hg2/ 1/1218703/2025 Whereas, the approval of CLU was merged with the approval of Layout Plan/Building Plan/ License to Develop Colonies in a single application, vide Notification No. 18/02/2023-5HG2/524 dated 24.03.2023 of this Department. However, considering the demand of the investors, who require permission for Change of Land Use for obtaining bank loan and NOC's of the other Departments. Further, CLU is important part of the application to get License to develop a colony as well as for standalone projects. Therefore, CLU permission is required to be de-linked from the approval of Building Plan/ Layout Plan.

In view of the above and in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 2(m) & Section 175 of the Punjab Regional and Town Planning and Development Act, 1995 and Section 2(l) & Section 41 of the Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act, 1995 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to partially amend the notifications regarding delegation of power and merging of CLU issued vide notification no. 13/41/21-6HG2/2476 dated 23.09.2022 & Notification no. 18/02/2023-5Hg2/524 dated 24.03.2023, and to supersede notifications of delegation of powers issued vide notification no. 13/41/2021-6HG2/2684 dated 19.10.2022, Notification no. 18/30/09/5Hg2/853 dated 12.06.2023, Notification no. 18/30/09 5Hg2/371 dated 14.03.2024 and Notification No. 18/30/09-5Hg2/513 Dated 15.04.2024 to the extent as mentioned below: -

1. CLU for all the standalone projects falling in the jurisdiction of Housing and Urban Development, Punjab (HUD) shall be issued separately by the Competent Authority of State Government as per the delegation of powers mentioned at **Annexure 'A'**.
2. Whereas CLU for all the standalone projects falling in the jurisdiction of Department of Local Government, Punjab (LG) shall be issued by Competent Authority as per notification no. 13/41/21-6HG2/2476 dated 23.09.2022 and Notification No. 13/41/21-6HG2/993 Dated 18.08.2025.
3. In case of colonies, the promoter shall have the option to either apply for CLU permission separately at first stage and get License to Develop Colony at Second Stage or to apply CLU-cum-Layout Plan/License to Develop Colony as a single application as per the



procedure contained in the Notification no. 18/02/2023-5Hg2/524 dated 24.03.2023 in the entire state of Punjab (HUD and LG).

However, the SoP for issuance of separate CLU, LoI/Layout Plan and License to develop Colony for the area falling in the jurisdiction of HUD is placed at **Annexure 'X'**.

4. The Competent Authority for approval of Building Plans, Layout Plans, Zoning Plans, License to Develop Colony, Compounding of Standalone Buildings, Completion and Occupancy Certificates for the cases falling in the Jurisdiction of Housing and Urban development shall be as per **Annexure 'B'**.
5. Whereas as per the statutory provisions under Section 83 of Punjab Regional and Town Planning and Development Act (PRTPD Act), 1995, any CLU permission shall remain in force in accordance with the terms and conditions of the CLU permission letter. Hence, in order to ensure early implementation of project on ground, the Competent Authority shall incorporate following standing condition while issuing the CLU permission to all category of projects in the entire State of Punjab (HUD and LG) that the CLU shall be valid for the period of two years from the date of issuance of CLU permission. If the CLU is not availed within the validity period, then the applicant may, before the expiry of CLU, apply for one time extension of validity of CLU for another two years on the payment of additional fee which shall be 20 percent of prevailing CLU and SIF charges. But this extension in no case shall exceed two years from change in the Master Plan, if any.

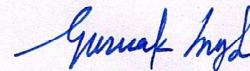

1. In case of standalone projects, building plans shall be approved by concerned Competent Authority after procuring ECBC compliance certificate issued by empanelled design expert of PEDDA.
2. These orders shall come into force with immediate effect.
3. The cases already applied in the offices of the previous Competent Authority before issuance of this notification shall be dealt by the previous Competent Authority.
4. Clarification, if any, shall be issued at the level of administrative secretary HUD.

Annexure 'X'

Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for issuing stage wise approval to colonies (including PAPRA exempted cases) for area falling under the jurisdiction of HUD:

Stage 1. CLU (23 Working days)

Stage 2. LoI/Layout Plan (30 Working days)

Stage 3. License to Develop Colony (30 Working days)

Stage-1 (CLU)

1. Applicant/Promoter shall submit an application for 'CLU to the O/o Senior Town Planner, of concerned circle along with CLU related documents as detailed in **Annexure 'X'**.
2. If application is in order, Senior Town Planner (STP) office shall forward the case to concerned District Town Planner (DTP) to seek field and technical report. **(3 working days)**
3. Concerned DTP office shall provide field and technical report to circle STP office **(5 working days)**.
4. STP office shall examine the case and if found feasible, the same shall be put up to Director, Town and Country Planning, Punjab for approval. **(7 working days)**.
5. Director, Town and Country Planning shall be the Competent Authority to give approval/rejection as the case may be **(3 working days)**
6. After the approval is received, Demand Notice shall be issued **(2 working days)**.
7. After the receipt of the fee, the CLU approval letter shall be issued by concerned STP **(3 working days)**.

Note: In case of Industrial Park, CLU approval up to 25 acres shall be issued by STP circle following the requisite steps.


Stage-2 (LoI/Layout)

1. Applicant/Promoter shall submit an application for Layout/License to Develop Colony to Concerned Chief Administrator of Development Authority/DTCP as the case may be.
2. The Layout Plan shall be examined in the committee as notified **(15 working days)**.
3. After the technical approval of Layout Plan by the Committee, the LOI shall be issued by the Chief Administrator of Development Authority in case of License Colony and Layout Plan approval in case exempted from License **(15 working days)**.

Stage-3 (License)



1. Applicant/Promoter shall submit fee and other compliance report/NOCs as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the LoI to Chief Administrator of Concerned Development Authority.
2. Concerned branches of the Development Authority shall provide report to Chief Administrator w.r.t. Compliance of LoI conditions **(15 working days)**.
3. Chief Administrator of Concerned Development Authority shall issue License to Develop Colony, if the terms and conditions of the LoI is complied with by the Applicant/Promoter **(15 working days)**.



Note: In case the Applicant/Promoter wishes to submit single application for CLU-cum-Layout Plan/License to Develop Colony, the same shall be considered as per the Notification dated 24.03.2023.
